*"PURPOSE OF FUND: This Fund is created and shall be operated exclusively for the benefit of Cooper Landing Senior Citizen Corporation, Inc. No part of the Fund shall benefit solely any individual or member of*

*of this Fund shall be to carry out propaganda, or to member of the Corporation. No part of the activities attempt to influence legislation. Nor shall any part of the activities of this Fund include attempts to participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. This includes the publication or distribution of any statements by a candidate. Notwithstanding any other provisions herein, this Fund shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization which is tax exempt, or by an organization's donations to which are deductible from taxable income to the extent allowed by provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and other applicable legislation and regulations as they now exist or may hereafter."*
